Santa Maria Improving Outcomes for Maternal and Child Health via Caring for Two Program

A \$200,000 grant from the Wellpoint Foundation will Expand the Program

Houston, Texas, (March 5, 2024) Santa Maria is improving maternal and child health outcomes for pregnant women or those with young children and their families who are impacted by or at risk for substance use and trauma, via the Caring for Two Program.

Caring for Two uses an integrated team and services including parenting education and coaching, counseling and behavioral health support, peer recovery support services, health care navigation and care coordination such as access to transportation and housing assistance, and linkage to substance use disorder treatment and medication assisted treatment when needed. These services are provided for women impacted by or at risk for substance use and trauma, their infants, and other family members. Services are home and community based and may extend for up to 18 months.

A \$200,000 grant from the Wellpoint Foundation will allow Santa Maria to expand translation services and recovery support services within the Caring for Two model. In addition, for the first time Santa Maria will add Doula Services for participants, including prenatal and post-partum services.

<u>Wellpoint</u> helps improve health care access and quality for nearly 750,000 Texans who participate in the state's Medicaid programs. Wellpoint Texas President, Greg Thompson, said supporting Santa Maria was a natural fit for the foundation.

"We are proud to partner with Santa Maria because they, like Wellpoint, are focused on a whole health approach. They are changing the lives of our most vulnerable populations by addressing multiple aspects of health and wellness," Thompson said. "They are working to improve maternal and infant health while addressing other factors including substance use disorder all while providing a safe living space so that families can stay together." With numerous community healthcare and social service partners the Caring for Two program is wide reaching, serving more than 900 women and children each year through home and community-based services. In addition, Santa Maria staff provides program services to families at community partner locations in the following zip codes: 77303, 77389, 77090, 77030, 77093, and 77521.

Women like Julie who participated in Santa Maria's Caring for Two program in 2020. Julie was battling substance use while pregnant when she entered residential treatment. While at Santa Maria and receiving all the services connected with Caring for Two, Julie was able to set a new course for her life, and most importantly have a safe and healthy delivery of her daughter Mia. Julie says today very little can bring her down and talks about how Mia has given her a second chance in life. "Now all my friends are moms" Julie said, "My life is much simpler, and I am so happy."

Evaluation of Caring for Two shows that the vital services and supported provided improves behavioral health and wellness, strengthens parent-child relationships, and builds family resiliency so that both mom and baby have the best opportunity to thrive," said Nadine Scamp, CEO of Santa Maria. In addition to being one of Texas' largest providers of substance-use treatment services for women, Santa Maria is also one of the few programs where a mother may bring her children with her into residential treatment. Santa Maria provides services to more than 6,000 women, children, and family members each year.
